## Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary Chapel

The Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary Chapel's sixteen gargoyles may have been inspired by Fr. Albouy's home country of France where they are very prevalent on Gothic-designed structures. The symbolism of these monster gargoyles was thought to either repel evil spirits, be architectural accents, or both. In addition, M.J. Riordan designed this Chapel's gargoyles as an integral part of the drainage system and to serve as downspouts. These sixteen gargoyles are the only examples existing in Flagstaff!

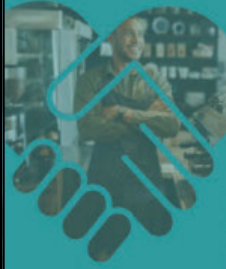
